## Nordic, Snowshoe & Uphill Ski Guide

### The Trails

Nub's Nob offers 20.8 km or 12 miles of groomed and tracked trails. All trails are 18 feet wide, power tilled, groomed and tracked when conditions allow. There is also 2 km or 1.25 miles of dedicated snowshoe and uphill ski terrain in natural condition.

### Cross Country & Snowshoe Loops

**Lower Blue:** 4.5 km or 2.8 miles of beginner/ intermediate terrain, this loop begins adjacent to the snowmaking reservoir in the northwest end of the ski area and is marked with blue markers. Available for Nordic skiing or snowshoeing

**Lower Red:** 1.1 km or 0.7 miles of beginner terrain, this loop is illuminated at night concurrent with regular night skiing hours. Trail starts at the Lower Blue trailhead and is marked with red markers. Available for Nordic skiing or snowshoeing.

**Upper Blue:** 8.5 km or 5.3 miles of expert terrain, consisting of numerous

hills and bends. The trail starts at the bottom of the Purple Chairlift and heads uphill along the edge of Big Time until heading into the woods on Skiers' Right of Fun Bowl, returning the same way. Please be watchful for inexperienced downhill skiers, the trail is marked with blue markers. Available for Nordic skiing and snowshoeing.

**Upper Red:** 5.1 km or 3.1 miles of expert terrain, consisting of fewer hills than the Upper Blue. The trail starts at the Upper Blue trailhead and is marked with red markers. Available for Nordic skiing and snowshoeing.

**Yellow Access Trail:** 1.6 km or 1 mile of access trail beginning with parking at the west end of Valley Rd., and connecting to the Nub's Nob trail network via the Upper Red Loop. The access trail is marked with yellow markers. Available to Nordic skiers and snowshoers.

### Uphill Skiing & Snowshoeing

**Upper Orange:** 2 km or 1.24 miles of expert terrain. Trail begins at the Lodge, but enters the woods immediately to the east of the Locker Building, north of tower 3 of the Purple Lift. The trail then climbs through the woods surrounding the Race Arena, offering uphill skiers access to ski downhill through the surrounding glades. This loop is marked with orange markers. Available to uphill skiers and snowshoers.

### The Rules

1. No pets. Their tracks compromise the trails for other customers, and can contaminate the snow or cause melting.
2. You must have a Ticket or Season Pass to use the trails. Snowshoers and XC skiers need a Season Pass or Trail Ticket, uphill skiers must have a downhill Lift Ticket or Season Pass. If parking at Valley Rd., you may purchase a ticket by phone at (231) 526-2131.
3. The trails are not regularly monitored by Ski Patrol, access them at your own risk.
4. Snowshoeing is allowed on all trails, but snowshoers must stay to the side of the trails and off of the track.
